






Mission: Chapter Books

Level	Task
1	read 2 chapter books under 100 pages each or 1 over 100 pages
2	read 4 chapter books under 100 pages each or 2 over 100 pages
3	read 6 chapter books under 100 pages each or 3 over 100 pages
	read 8 chapter books under 100 pages each or 4

4	read 8 informational texts of under 100 pages each or 4 over 100 pages


Challenge Mission Details

Code	Title	Task	
ABC	Alphabet	Read 26 books with each representing an alphabet letter based on the title.	
COL	Colors	Read books that have a color in the title - 7 different colors (rainbow or your choice paint palette)	
HOL	Holidays	Read 10 books about one holiday or 1 book each about 10 different holidays.	
LIST	Reading List	Read 5 books from one of our school's resource lists (ex: ladybug books, award-winners, classics)	
MUCU	Multicultural	Read 5 picture books or 2 chapter books from our school's resource list of diversity books	
HIST	Time Warp	Read 5 books from a resource list based on a particular time period	
MCL	Public Library	With library card in hand, borrow and read a couple books or attend an even at Manchester City Library.	
EBK	Ebooks	Read 3 electronic books of your choice.	
GNR	Genre	Read 10 books, 1 for each specified genre	
LANG	Languages	3 ways to complete this - read a book written entirely in another language, read 2 books that include non-English words, or learn 20 words in another language through language dictionaries or written notes	




Challenge missions may be completed as many times as the student wants. Each completion will earn an additional star on their challenge completion badge on the tracking board.

How do you show us you've completed a challenge mission?








GAB mission tracking version 1 - generic



GAB Relay Activity

- Groups will send 1 person to get a book from their bin on the stage stairs.
- Return to table and group will decide what kind of book it is
 - Picture book
 - Wordless picture book
 - Informational
 - Graphic Novel/Comic
 - Chapter Book
 - Concept Book
- Person who got the book will take the post-it from the front of the book and place it on the correct place on the corresponding chart paper.
- Once person returns to group, the next person in the group will get a book from their bin and the process repeats until time is called or all 20 books are placed.
